


# Finding Your Way Around the Classroom


# Finding Your Way Around the Classroom



To enter the forum click on the button in the left-hand sidebar. In the forum, we will ask questions, share our exercises and give feedback.



In this course, we focus our attention on turning the events of our ancestor's life into scenes. Scenes are the hallmark of engaging stories. Without them, our stories are dry and lifeless. Through our six weeks together, we look at the difference between scene and summary. We cover the various elements required to write a scene including description, dialogue, and conflict. We learn to add layers of emotion and theme to our scenes. By the end, family history writers will have a full understanding of scene writing and will be on their way to practicing and improving their scenes to write engaging family history stories. We keep these classes small so that we can critique each other's work, get one on one help, and learn from each other.
